Juvenile Rules 18/19

In order for badminton to be a fun and enjoyable time for all our young players, we would ask that you carefully read through the rules outlined below with your child and sign the accompanying form.

- A strict no bullying policy is operated in the club to ensure badminton is enjoyable for everyone.
- Children are asked to behave appropriately during badminton, treating other members and coaches with respect, as well as listening carefully to directions given to them and trying their best at all times. A record of misbehaviour during badminton will be kept, if a child receives three warnings over a period of time they will be given a four week suspension from badminton. If the child receives two further warnings (five in total), they will not be permitted to return to badminton for the duration of the 2018/2019 year.
- Mobile phones are not permitted to be used during juvenile badminton. We would advise that children do not bring mobile phones with them at all as the coaches on duty each night will be able to contact a parent/guardian in case of emergency or for any other reason. If your child does need to bring a phone with them, they will be asked to leave their phone in the box by the kitchen/viewing area. The club cannot take any responsibility for loss or damage to phones/other belongings.
- No chewing gum is allowed in the hall.
- Appropriate sportswear must be worn when attending badminton (i.e. Tracksuits and Runners). For safety reasons if a child is not wearing suitable attire they will not be permitted to participate on that given night.
- If a child is borrowing a racket owned by the club on any given night, they are expected to return the racket in the same condition as it was taken.
- A juvenile membership form must be completed by both the child seeking membership and their parent/guardian before the child will be permitted to play. It is necessary that the club holds contact details/ medical concerns etc for insurance purposes before a child begins playing.
